MNPS Survey Percentage Agreeing with Statements Related to Safety and Positive School Climate: 2003

MNPS 2002-2003: By August 2002, amend the MNPS school survey for parents, conduct survey and analyze results.

Comment: *A majority of parents and elementary school children reported schools that are positive and welcoming. Less than half of students in grade 5-11 reported that school environments were positive and welcoming. A majority of students, parents, teachers and non-teachers reported positives of attitudes about school safety. Less than half of students in grade 5 reported positive attitudes about school safety.*
